Friedrich Gernsheim (1839–1916) was a prolific German composer. He was a conductor in Saarbrücken, taught at the Cologne Conservatory, was musical director of the Philharmonic Society of Rotterdam, and taught at the Stern Conservatory in Berlin. Because he was Jewish, his music was banned in Nazi Germany, and writings about him were removed from music libraries.
