He was organist at Grace Chapel, NYC, at Middle Dutch Collegiate Church, NYC, and was a founder of the American Guild of Organists. He was conductor of the Bayonne City Philharmonic Society, New Jersey. He died in Manhattan, NYC. He composed a number of church works, piano pieces, and carols.
